


- Small flat blade screwdriver
- Phillips screwdriver

Attention! With the key out of the ignition, disconnect the negative battery terminal before installing this product. Ensure that all installation connections are secure before cycling the ignition to test this product.


DASH DISASSEMBLY

- Unclip and remove entire panel surrounding radio and a/c control all the way over to left side of steering wheel. (Figure A)
- **2.** Remove (5) Phillips screws securing the radio and pocket assembly. (Figure B)
- Remove (2) Phillips screws (1 per side) securing factory pocket to radio/pocket bracket assembly.(Figure C, D)




KIT PREPARATION

- Attach the radio housing brackets to the radio housing using the included carriage bolts and Keps nuts. (Figure A)
- Position the factory pocket into the assembled radio housing assembly and secure with the factory hardware. (Figure B)




KIT ASSEMBLY

DIN radio provision with pocket

- Slide the DIN cage into the radio housing assembly and secure by bending the metal locking tabs down. (Figure A)
- 2. Slide the aftermarket radio into the cage and secure. (Figure B)
- Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna plug in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapters from Metra and/or AXXESS.
- **4.** Mount the new radio assembly into the dash and reassemble the dash in reverse order of disassembly.







ISO DIN radio provision with pocket

- Remove the metal "DIN" sleeve and plastic trim ring from the aftermarket radio.
- Mount the ISO brackets to the radio with the screws supplied with the radio. (Figure A)
- **3.** Slide the radio into the radio opening until the side clips engage. (Figure B)
- **4.** Snap the **trim plate** into the **radio housing**. (Figure B)
- Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna plug in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapters from Metra and/or AXXESS.
- **6.** Mount the new radio assembly into the dash and reassemble the dash in reverse order of disassembly.
