ATTENTION: With the key out of the ignition, disconnect the negative battery terminal before installing this product. Ensure that all installation connections, especially the air bag indicator lights, are plugged in before reconnecting the battery or cycling the ignition to test this product. NOTE: Refer also to the instructions included with the aftermarket accessory before installing this device.

INSTALLATION OPTIONS

Adding a full-range amp and subwoofer to a factory system:

This feature offers the ability to add a full-range amp and sub to a factory system, whether amplified* or non-amplified. (refer to **Pages 3 & 4**)

* For amplified models the amp must be bypassed/unplugged. Refer to www.MetraOnline.com for the vehicle specific amplifier bypass harness.

Note: The interface provides a 12-volt 1-amp output to turn on aftermarket amp(s). If installing multiple amps, an SPDT automotive relay will be required if the amp turn-on current of all amps combined exceeds 1-amp. Use Metra part number E-123 (sold separately) for best results.

INSTALLATION

- Disassemble the dash, unplug all connectors, and remove the factory radio.*
- Install the AXAMP-CH5 vehicle T-harness to the vehicle radio harness and make all the necessary connections. Leave the 2-pin amp turn on wire disconnected.
- **3.** Plug the 20-pin harness from the **AXAMP- CH5 T-harness** into the interface.
- **4.** Connect the Amp Turn-on wire.
- *NOTE: If the vehicle is amplified, connect the 8-pin harness "A" to 8-pin harness "C". If the factory system is not amplified **DO NOT** connect the 2-pin harness. (See system graphics on pages 4 & 5)
- **5.** Connect the 2-pin **Amp Turn On Wire** to the interface and then connect to the aftermarket amplifiers.
- Connect RCAs to the FRONT, REAR or SUB output of the AXAMP-CH5 interface, then connect to the corresponding amplifier.
- **7.** Adjust your aftermarket amplifier to a desired listening level.

Bass Knob Adjustment:

The bass knob connects to the 2 wires from the 20-pin connector labeled **BASS KNOB**.

The bass knob is used to adjust the output of Channels 5 & 6 of the AXAMP.

Adjustment is as follows:

- **Counterclockwise** turn lowers the volume of channels 5 & 6.
- **Clockwise** turn raises the volume of channels 5 & 6.

RPAD Installation

RPAD Year Range: 15-17 (RPAD)

18 UP (RPAD2)

NOTE: If the vehicle is not amplified, you will need to install the included RPAD or RPAD2 to the 8-pin harness "C" located on the **vehicle T-harness** plugged into the factory radio.

If the vehicle is amplified, connect the 8-pin harness "A" to 8-pin harness "C".

Extension Harness


- Connect the included Extension Harness 8-pin harness "B" to the 8-pin harness "A" on the vehicle T-harness to connect factor speaker locations.
- **2.** Connect the end of the **Extension Harness** to the aftermarket amplifier.



REBOOTING THE U-CONNECT RADIO

The factory U-Connect Radio will require a reboot process to accept the aftermarket interface/or add a camera. Disconnecting
the main harness to install a T-harness and repowering the radio may cause U-Connect Radio to program as a different model
of vehicle than it was programed to originally. Below are the different U-Connect initial Splash/Boot Up screens for vehicle types.

SPLASH/BOOT UP COLORS

Chrysler: Blue

Dodge/Ram: Red

Jeep: Orange



REBOOTING STEPS

- Turn the Key or Press Push to Start Button to the ACC position.
 DO NOT press brake on Push to Start vehicles.
- 2. Press the Volume **PWR/MUTE** button and **TUNE/ENTER** button for 10-16 seconds, until the radio reboots.
- **3.** Let go once the radio reboots, now you have successfully rebooted your factory radio.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Final LED Feedback

At the end of programming the LED will turn **Solid Green** which indicates programming was successful. If the LED didn't turn **Solid Green**, reference the list below to understand which programming section the problem may stem from.

Feedback Light	Condition/Status
Solid Green	All Good
Solid Red	Missing CAN Frames
Blink Red	Clipping Output
Green/Red	Missing Adv. (Comm Frames)
